

# [intransit] Producers

## **You are in transit.**

Take your first step into the producing world with b-side and programme & produce your very own Young Person Festival (called WHY? Festival) at b-side Festival 2018.

b-side Festival takes place 08 - 16 September.

WHY? Festival will take place 13 - 15 September.

## **As an [intransit] Producer you will:**

- Receive training & mentorship from b-side team & outside practitioners
- Help b-side produce a platform for Young People during the Festival
- Work with a budget & learn about fundraising on the go
- Be paid for your time
- Be aged 16 - 25 (or thereabouts)
- Be passionate about championing a festival for young people

The 5 selected [intransit] Producers will meet twice a month (from March onwards) in a venue in Dorset. The proposed meetings dates are the 2nd & 4th Thursday of each month between 6:30pm - 8:30pm at Outpost on Portland. The dates & venue of the [intransit] meetings are not final and can be discussed with participants.



## ABOUT WHY? FESTIVAL

The WHY? Festival is in direct response to the UN Convention on the Rights of the Child. Together, the [intransit] producers will build a programme of events, workshops and performances in response to the document.

- Founded in 2014 by Southbank Centre Artistic Director Jude Kelly
- Inspired by the UN Convention on the Rights of the Child
- Aim is to inspire young people to engage in discussion
- The festival offers workshops, performance and debates
- The festival revolves around YP rights to arts and culture
- Rights to play, to education, to care & freedom of expression
- The aim is to inspire & enable YP to have a voice / to take action

The [intransit] Producers will consult with other members of the young community in Dorset throughout the process. This will help the group gather ideas and respond to local queries, questions and issues.

The [intransit] Producers will get the chance to invite people from all over the UK and even the world to speak at this event.

b-side have already made connections with young people in Portland Oregon, B Sharp & The Complete Freedom of Truth Project.
